This year's Conference holds special significance as we celebrate **CCF's 20th anniversary**—a major milestone in our commitment to collaboration, education, and progress.

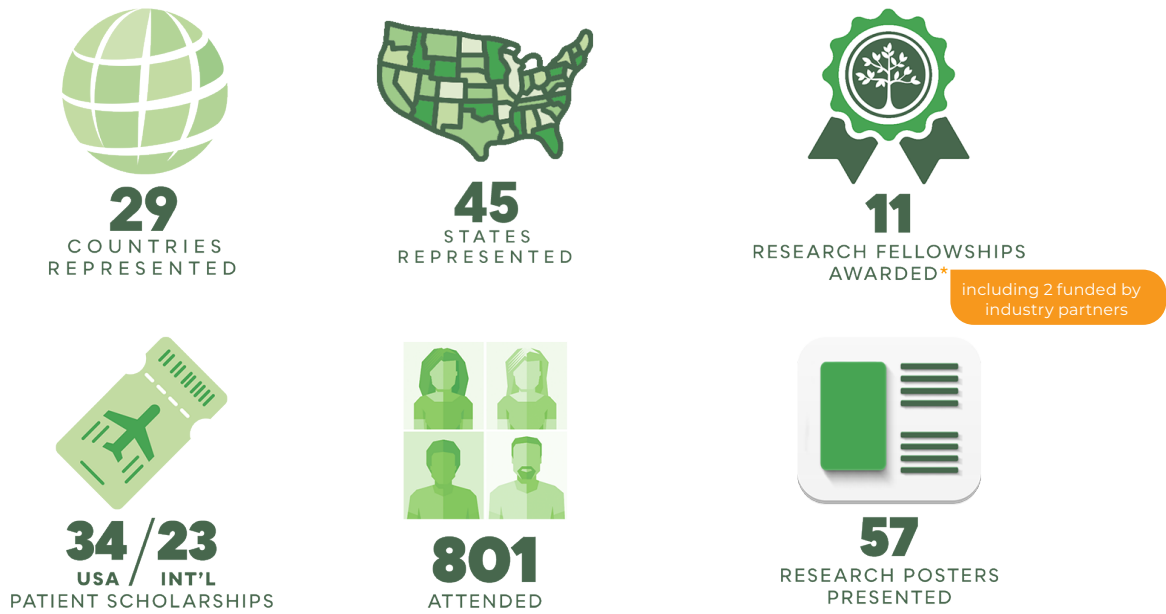

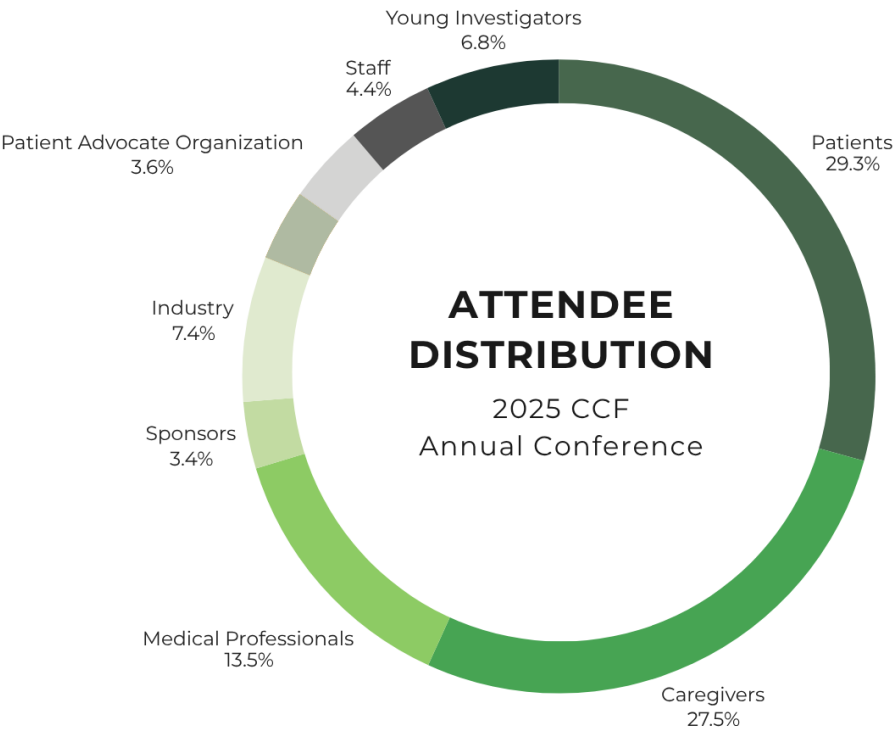

2025 Annual Conference Highlights



CCF conducted an International Consensus on Research Priorities via **10 specialized Working Groups**, where participants evaluated the current state of science and proposed focused, high-impact areas for future research funding. CCF will develop a single manuscript summarizing the priorities and submit it to a **peer-reviewed journal**, advancing visibility, funding, and progress.

Industry Forum

The Industry Forum allows companies to present research, clinical trials, educational initiatives, or commercial programs to a panel of key opinion leaders (KOLs) in cholangiocarcinoma through CCF's International Cholangiocarcinoma Research Network (ICRN), a global consortium of 429 members from 206 institutions in 34 countries. Each 30-minute session includes a 15-minute presentation followed by 15 minutes of Q&A and feedback from ICRN members. The ICRN's 30–40 attendees typically include clinical investigators, medical and radiation oncologists, Phase I specialists, surgeons, scientists, and patient advocates. This multidisciplinary group provides companies with comprehensive, global insight into their trials or treatment strategies.

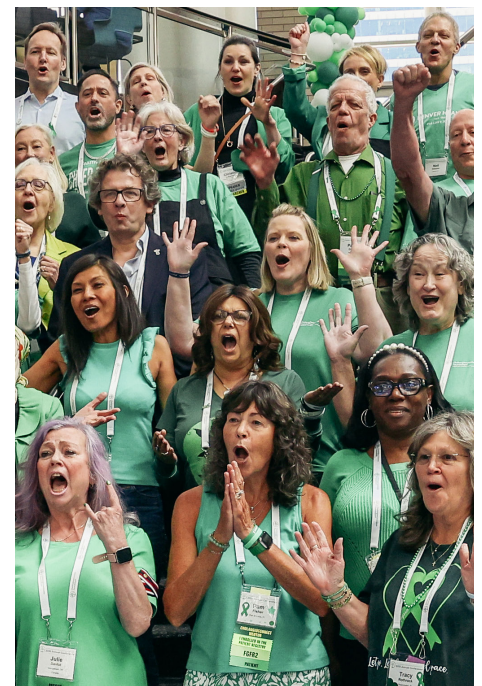

CCF will coordinate, host, and facilitate the advisory board meeting, which typically lasts 2 hours and is moderated by CCF's Chief Patient Officer, Melinda Bachini. Panels generally consist of 6–8 individuals with diverse experiences, treatment stages, and backgrounds to ensure a well-rounded discussion.
