NEW! Annual Industry Webinar

The Annual Industry Webinar is a unique, once-a-year educational event designed for patients, caregivers, healthcare professionals, and the broader CCA community. The program features two main components: a review of the latest updates and data from the 2026 ASCO Annual Meeting in Chicago, and direct presentations from CCF's pharmaceutical and biotech partners. Each partner has 5–10 minutes to share ASCO updates, clinical trial information, therapeutic developments, and patient-relevant insights, providing a valuable platform to connect directly with the CCA community. With up to 260 live attendees and post-event recordings averaging 300+ views—and some exceeding 3,000—this webinar ensures that your message continues to reach and impact patients, caregivers, and providers well beyond the live session.

Through landmark lightings, global outreach, and targeted campaigns, we work to raise visibility and build year-round momentum. Research and Innovation Program

CCF's Fellowship Program accelerates progress in cholangiocarcinoma by funding promising investigators through targeted fellowships. We offer a 1-Year Early-Career Fellowship and a 3-Year Mid-Career Training Grant to support innovative research at critical career stages. With over \$6.4M invested since 2006, your sponsorship fuels scientific discovery and drives better outcomes in a highly underserved cancer space.

Educational Webinars

CCF's Educational Webinars provide sponsors with a valuable opportunity to present CCA-specific therapies to a highly engaged audience of patients, caregivers, and healthcare professionals. These webinars help translate complex science into accessible information, highlight clinical trial opportunities, and empower participants to make informed decisions.
