The Cholangiocarcinoma Foundation's (CCF) mission is to find a cure and improve the quality of life for those affected by cholangiocarcinoma (CCA). Founded in 2006 in Salt Lake City, Utah, by a family that lost a loved one to cholangiocarcinoma, CCF has become a leading global resource in patient support, education, advocacy, and funding basic, clinical, and translational research. The organization's core values are patients first, collaboration, innovation, and urgency.

#### **About Team CCF**

Team CCF began in 2016 to raise money through athletic events for the Cholangiocarcinoma Foundation. Over the years, Team CCF has participated in numerous races, such as the TCS New York City Marathon, Bank of America Chicago Marathon, Denver/Colfax Marathon, Philadelphia Marathon, Los Angeles Marathon, and the Monumental Indianapolis Marathon.

Since 2016, over **430** athletes have participated in **48** athletic events nationwide, raising over **\$1.85** million in funds for cholangiocarcinoma research and patient services. Team CCF enables community members to connect, share their experiences, and make a positive change while participating in an event promoting physical and emotional wellness.
